

ARTICLE 4
MARINE OPERATIONS

SEC. 4.01 - REGULATION OF VESSELS - DISABLED,
GROUNDED AND BEACHED

(a) Any disabled vessel or any vessel in such condition as to create a danger to persons or property shall be subject to, and the owner or person in custody or control of such vessel shall comply with, all orders or directions of the Port Director with regard to the disposition of such vessel.

(b) It shall be unlawful for the owner or person in custody or control of any vessel to ground or beach said vessel on San Diego Bay tide or submerged lands without the express prior permission of the Port Director.

SEC. 4.02 - REGULATION OF VESSELS - BERTHING AND
MOORING

Any vessel berthing at a wharf, pier or bulkhead or mooring in the harbor shall be subject to, and the owner or person in custody or control of such vessel shall comply with, orders or directions of the Port Director with regard to such berthing or mooring.
